EH&S Update – Mary Meyer

- Mary reviewed the certified mail packet each CAP participants receive. In addition, she noted some pause with recent governmental changes, however Dow continues to conduct groundwater sampling.

Site and IPark Updates – Eleanor Joffrion

- Site updates on technological advancements happening within Dow and how its progress is helpful with the next generation.
- Also noted the iPark communication meetings, RTO for Glycol 2 and Eagleray.

Glycol 2 Update – Glynn Mayers and Mary Meyer

- Return to Operations
 - Dow has made significant progress on the re-construction of the Glycol-2 Unit at its Louisiana Operations in Plaquemine, Louisiana. Long lead time equipment has been procured, the foundation has been poured, and we are moving into the steel construction phase of the rebuild. The finishing section of the plant is being redesigned consistent with learnings from the company's internal investigation. Additionally, we are enhancing our vessel closure process and continue to develop technology solutions to improve our processes. Following the arrival of critical path equipment, we will move toward mechanical completion of the rebuild. We remain on track for a safe and successful startup. We anticipate restart in late 2Q24, within our reasonable control. As we progress further into the rebuild, Dow remains committed to communicating any substantial timing shifts or updates prior to restart.
- Mary explained some troubleshooting and corrective actions the RCI findings and how the RCI has helped the facilities run smoother and make positive changes throughout Dow.
- Noted recent communications and media on the EPA and OSHA investigations. Stated that there have been no other media inquiries.
- Glycol 2 incident page is being consistently updated, all questions can be referred to that site.
