The CAP meeting was held at the Dow Pecan Grove House in Plaquemine.

Dave Wilson, Louisiana Operation's Responsible Care Leader, began the meeting with the EH&S updates. The man-hours at the end of the year decreased as the projects wrapped up for 2018. There were 12 injuries in 2018 for a .32. LAO went 125 days without an injury. On March 5, 2019 there was a serious contractor injury.

Wilson also gave the CAP members a brief update on activities conducted during 4Q of 2018, pursuant to the cooperative agreement pertaining to implementation of groundwater remediation. He reminded the CAP members that they receive copies of the quarterly summary of the cooperative agreement activities in the mail.

Kevin Cadien, Site Director, reported that Dow Dupont reported 4Q 2018 EBITDA was \$3.9 Billion, flat with the year-ago period. Cash flow will be a big focus for 2019. The Company returned \$2.3 Billion to shareholders in the quarter through dividends and share repurchases.

Dow is anticipated to separate from the merger on April 1, 2019. Dupont and Corteva will split on June 1, 2019. Dow will remain the Materials Science Company, while Dupont will be Specialty Products and Corteva will be Agriculture.

James Watkins, Site Integration Leader, discussed that the work continues on the new MRO (Spare Parts) warehouse, which is located across from the site, off of La 1. Move in is expected for June/July of this year.

Abby Barden, LAO Public Affairs Manager, discussed the new Think a Bit Lab at Cohn Elementary in Port Allen with the Grand Opening in a few days. The Knock Knock Children's Museum in Baton Rouge will be hosting Community Free Days on the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of each month. Dow is a partner with Knock Knock and sponsor of March's Free Day. Coming up this spring, Dow will participate in the Live after 5's in Baton Rouge and Addis, as well as Boogie on the Bayou in Plaquemine. Also we are a partner with "Bike Brusly" and have had employee clean-up teams in Plaquemine and West Baton Rouge Parish, as part of our commitment to contribute 7,000 hours of volunteer time to our local communities in 2019.
