The CAP meeting was held at the Dow Pecan Grove House in Plaquemine.

Dave Wilson, Louisiana Operation's Responsible Care Leader, began the meeting with the EH&S updates. He stated that we have 3,000 people entering the site daily, giving the site over 6 million man-hours. We are expected to enter over 7 ½ million man-hours by the end of 2018. We had 3 injuries in October and 2 Agency Reportables. The reportables were due to the power outage we had in September.

Wilson also gave the CAP members a brief update on activities conducted during the 3rd qtr. of 2018, pursuant to the cooperative agreement pertaining to implementation of groundwater remediation. He reminded the CAP members that they receive copies of the quarterly summary of the cooperative agreement activities in the mail.

Kevin Cadien, Site Director, announced that Dow Dupont reported 3rd Quarter, 2018 results on November 1, 2018. Operating EBITDA increased 19% to \$5.7 Billion. Net sales increased 10% to \$20.1 Billion. Plastics is 50% of the earnings/sales throughout the company.

We continue to anticipate Materials Science will spin off by the end of the first quarter, 2019.

Dow was awarded the LCA 2018 SAFE Award, "Best in Class" for big companies.

Cadien discussed that the railroad track on LA 1 was worked on the evening of Thursday, November 1st to make repairs. Only one lane was closed each way during the repairs.

James Watkins, Site Integration Leader, discussed that the work continues on the new MRO (Spare Parts) warehouse, which is located across from the site, off of La 1. The building slab has been poured. Scheduled completion in April 2019.

Abby Barden, LAO Public Affairs Manager, discussed that the 4Q Safety Saturday was held on Saturday, October 28th during the HHMD Day at Myhand Park in Addis. 200+ Cars came to HHMD Day, that's 50 more than last year. Dow also sponsored the Live After 5 in Addis on the Westside on November 2nd. Approx. 100 employees and family members attended to enjoy

the band, Bag of Donuts. LAO's WIN ERG supported "Define Your Selfie" event in partnership with local Wellness Studio for high school girls at Port Allen High School. This aligns with Dow's support of mental health in the local communities.
