The CAP meeting was held at the Dow Plantation House in Plaquemine.

Eduardo Do Val, Site Director for Louisiana Operations, discussed the March announcement between Dow and Olin under which Dow will separate its U.S. Gulf Coast Chlor-Alkali and Vinyl, Global Chlorinated Organics and Global Epoxy businesses, and then merge these businesses with Olin in a Reverse Morris Trust transaction. The deal is expected to be completed by the year-end.

Do Val also spoke about the May announcement to reduce Dow's global workforce by 3%. Do Val stated that all growth projects for Louisiana Operations remain on schedule.

Mike Albano, Responsible Care Leader of Louisiana Operations, reviewed quarterly statistics on environmental, health and safety metrics. Albano summarized the most recent reporting of well sampling data pursuant to the cooperative agreement between EPA and LDEQ.

Stacey Chiasson, Public Affairs Leader, stated that over 80 applications were received for Dow's 2015 PTEC scholarship award and that \$50,000 will be awarded in the local community. She also shared how Dow's national sponsorship of "Project Lead the Way" will impact Plaquemine High and the newly announced Dow STEM Academy in West Baton Rouge Parish. Dow also made a \$20,000 contribution to the CRISIS Coalition to advance policy and progression of a traffic & infrastructure plan for the Capital region.
