

Louisiana Operations Community Advisory Panel (CAP) Meeting

The CAP meeting was held at the Dow Plantation House in Plaquemine. The CAP members were also given a tour of the Louisiana Operations Site.

Eduardo Do Val, Site Director for Louisiana Operations, announced that for the 11<sup>th</sup> consecutive quarter, Dow has met or exceeded earnings. Earnings per share were up 23% over the same period a year ago. EBITDA increased to its highest all-time 2Q operating earnings. Do Val said the Gulfstream growth projects are on schedule and will be seen on the window tour after the meeting.

Mike Albano, Responsible Care Leader for Louisiana Operations, reviewed environmental, health and safety metrics for the most recent quarter. Albano reminded the CAP members that they will receive copies of the quarterly summary of activities conducted pursuant to the cooperative agreement pertaining to implementation of groundwater remediation in the mail. Although EH&S performance continues to be good, leadership has implemented a Special Emphasis on Safety due to heat and also additional work taking place on site with growth projects and turnarounds. As stated by Albano, purposeful engagement is key to continued excellence in EH&S performance, emphasizing Safety First, Pounds Second.

Stacey Chiasson, Public Affairs Leader, is spending approximately 30% of her time on traffic and infrastructure challenges in the region. Dow is using a video series on traffic and infrastructure to engage employees on the issue. Project Lead the Way, a STEM based curriculum that is sponsored by Dow in West Baton Rouge and Iberville schools has started and is reported as well attended.

Stacey then invited the CAP members on an hour long window tour, guided by Larry Rushing. The tour highlighted new construction as part of Dow's Gulfstream Project.
