Groundwater Update

- On March 15 Dow submitted two annual reviews for 2023 and CAP members provided a copy.
- Sampling was conducted on May 6 and completed May 16. LDEQ was present. They are no results from this sampling available yet.

Site and IPark Updates – Mary Meyer

- Poly B completing two turnarounds in April and through June.
- Glycol 2 is scheduled for startup in Q2.

Glycol 2 Update

- The Dow team talked through the safer redesign and rebuild of Glycol 2, including the Return to Operations (commissioning and startup) process.
- The community will have no impact from the startup of the unit, but Dow leadership will stay in constant contact with OEP directors and CAP members during the process. The LAO Incident page is up to date and for the community to receive updated information.
- No community concerns and feedback on the restart if the unit were voiced during the meeting.
- West Baton Rouge and Iberville Parish OEP directors requested contact prior to start up and the team committed to engaging in a plus/delta with the OEP leaders from the incident.
