- o Groundwater Update
  - Second quarter sampling has been completed and no vinyl chloride was detected. The complete summary was mailed out to CAP members in early August.
- o Site Performance and Proceed with Caution campaign
  - The site rolled out a 'Proceed with Caution' campaign to address a recent uptick in site injuries. The campaign has been a success, and the site is at 72 days injury free.

# Site and IPark Updates - Eleanor Joffrion

- Turnaround updates:
  - Hydrocarbons will have a 'mega' turnaround in 2025. The site will stay close to parish officials on details but can expect an increase in traffic, occupancy of local housing and hotels and patronage of local restaurants.
  - o Poly B plant, Train 3 is in a turnaround.
  - o Large turnaround on gas turbines on Project Eagleray wrapped up in July.
  - In Q3, Olin will have an outage. The site is continuing partnership and management to ensure safe outage.
- The site is implanting digital resources for the turnarounds, including best practices. The site is also leveraging resources and expertise across Dow sites for TA's.
- Railroad work on LA 1 is underway and the site is working with local leaders.
