EH&S Update – Mary Meyer

 Final ground water data for Q4 has been validated and met all standards (two wells in cane field are in contingency status). 2025 Q1 samples are undergoing validation. Dow has been working with LDEQ for 23 years now to monitor wells.

Diamond Infrastructure Solutions – Eleanor Joffrion, Wes Heinlein

- Dow has announced partnership with Macquarie Asset Management to launch Diamond Infrastructure Solutions or "Diamond". Diamond will be comprised of certain non-product producing assets including
 - o power and steam production
 - o pipeline, caverns/wells
 - o environmental operations
 - o general site infrastructure
- Dow will sell minority ownership in Dow U.S. Gulf Coast infrastructure assets to a fund managed by Macquarie Asset Management, a leading global infrastructure and energy asset manager.
- Dow will maintain control as the majority owner of Diamond to help ensure the continuity of safe and reliable operations.

Dow Earnings – Wes Heinlein

- Fourth quarter performance shows that we are still in a slump. This is the third prolonged "trough period" since the 1970s. We are expecting performance to remain slow through 2025 as there is not a high demand for many of our products.
- Dow is undergoing a restructuring there will be approximately 1500 global layoffs. This is not expected to have a large impact on LAO as our site is operating at above 90%.
