Dow in Texas

Dow Texas at a Glance

- Texas Operations in Freeport is Dow's largest integrated manufacturing site, and the largest single company chemical complex in the world, with more than **40** production plants that manufacture over **40 percent** of Dow products sold in the U.S. and **25 percent** sold globally
- Texas Operations generates **550 MW** of power. This represents the amount used by approximately 343,750 homes, or roughly equivalent to thirty-five percent of housing units in the City of Houston
- The industrial raw water system at Dow's Texas Operations supplies water to Brazosport Water Authority for treatment and distribution to multiple local municipalities and water directly to thirteen additional industrial users
- Deer Park is the largest manufacturer of methacrylic and acrylic monomers in the world

Dow Products Made in Texas

Research, development and/or manufacturing at Dow's Texas sites include key ingredients and innovations that enable hundreds of everyday products, including:

- Methacrylic and acrylic monomers that are used for paints, adhesives, sealants, paper and coatings
- Polymeric emulsions that are used to manufacture water-based paints, traffic paints, adhesives, caulk, and other household and industrial products
- Basic and performance plastics and chemicals, which include hundreds of industrial and consumer applications such as electronics, communications, food packaging and health care

Contributing to Community Success

- More than \$1.1 million in annual donations were given across Texas through The Dow Chemical Company Foundation
- In 2022, more than 1,500 Dow employees in Texas volunteered approx. 6,900 hours on more than 250 projects.
