Transition of Laminating Adhesives Business to Arkema: Impact on Your Invoicing Process

Dear Valued Supplier,

On May 2, 2024, Dow announced it reached an agreement with Arkema, a leader in specialty materials, outlining the intention to divest its Laminating Adhesives business, part of the Packaging & Specialty Plastics portfolio. The scope of the divestiture includes the associated business segment and manufacturing sites at Ringwood and Elk Grove, Illinois, USA; Mozzate and Parona, Italy; and Toluca, México. The Taloja, India, site will remain with Dow Chemical International Private Limited (Dow India) and will contract manufacture to Arkema.

You have been identified as a carrier that is currently invoicing The Dow Chemical Company's Laminating Adhesives business via Cass.

How will this change impact you?

As the Laminating Adhesives Business transitions into Arkema, you will need to follow an updated invoicing process for those shipments in scope to move to Arkema. Invoices for shipments on or after December 2, 2024, must change to this new process.

Outbound shipment-related invoices are to be billed to:

- All transportation modes: FUSELAPBostik@dow.com
- Scripts/Uploads: FUSFSCRBostik@dow.com

It is imperative that these new work processes are adapted into your business to ensure timely invoice processing and payment.
